

# Other Points of Interest

#### **Robena Mine Disaster of 1962**

A marker, honoring 37 killed in an explosion at Robena mine. This led to the creation of the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA).

**Location:** Rt. 21 near Masontown and Greene County Coal Miners Memorial, I-79 Pennsylvania Welcome Center, Whiteley

#### Jock Yablonski

A marker for Jock Yablonski, a UMW leader and dissident who, in 1969, was killed alongside his wife and daughter shortly after his defeat as a union reform candidate.

Location: Roadside marker, 3<sup>rd</sup> & Wood St., California, PA
